ABOUT THE COLLEGE

The Tamil Evangelical Lutheran Church f (T.E.L.C) was born in 1919 to serve the cause of the poor, downtrodden and the marginalized sections of the Tamil Society. Realising the need for the establishment of a centre for higher education the T.E.L.C. chose Porayar, a rural hamlet in the erstwhile Thanjavur District for starting its first higher education institution. The vision was brought into reality with the rise of Tranquebar Bishop Manikam Lutheran College which was named after Late Rt. Rev. Dr. R. B. Manikam, the first Indian Bishop of the church. It became an important landmark in the annals of the T.E.L.C on 19th June 1972. The Government of Tamil Nadu approved the establishment of the college vide its Government Order No. 1888, Education Department dated 29.11.1972. The college now offers fourteen undergraduate, twelve postgraduate courses and eight research programme leading to M.Phil., and Ph.D.
